There are nine teams named after secret agents, **James Bond, Richard Hannay, Jason Bourne, George Smiley, Alex Rider, Jack Ryan, Bernard Samson, Nikita** and **Jack Bauer**.

Each team's first clue is in [REDACTED]. Feel free to follow the other teams. It won't help you at all because their clues are different and will send them to different locations but at least it will be entertaining for me as I monitor you from above.

Each clue will lead you to a tube station although the answers you require will *not* be found in the station. You will need to exit the station to find the answers, even if you have to return to continue your journey. However, travelling by tube may not always be the fastest or most direct route. It's your call.

Time is of the essence. Don't dawdle. Only the fastest team will win and at 7.15 Ethan will be fed to the piranhas. And if that isn't motivation enough for you, if you fail to arrive by then you'll go hungry. Life is cruel. Allow yourselves at **least 20 minutes** to complete your final journey in clue 7.

I have been informed that all of you regard yourselves geniuses. So, no simple clues for you, then! Feel free to phone a friend, browse the net or attempt to bribe me – but first you'll have to find me and you probably can't afford my price. Just ensure that you solve each clue correctly or you'll end up cold, lonely, hungry and the laughing stock of Procter and Gamble!

If time runs out, you cannot solve a clue, the pressure is too great, the hunger pangs cripple you or you simply wimp out you I, The Voice, may be persuaded to help you. ### Clue 1:
